

The MAPJ board met on September 17th, 2009pm at Radina's coffee shop meeting room. Members present were Chair, Jon Tveite, Treasurer Anne Cowan, Newsletter editor David Buck, Majka Jankowiak, Greg Covington, Christopher Renner, John Exdell, and MAPJ coordinator Victor Force.

The Minutes from the August meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Cowan reported that the balance for all accounts was \$16,670.62. Cowan told the board that we have not paid for the last newsletter yet.

Fundraising: Cowan reported that the fundraising committee would meet at 5:15 pm on Monday, September 21st at her home.

Campus: Force reported that he will work with Rob to get the campus organizations together. Kelley of Amnesty International will write an article for our next newsletter. Amnesty International students may approach the MAPJ board for funds in order for them to go to a conference in the future.

Movie: Renner reported that just under 100 people were in attendance at the two showings of "Anthrax War". Renner reported that the next movie will be "What's the Matter With Kansas?" We will show it on Oct. 13th at 6:30 pm at the Manhattan Public Library.

Radio: Renner said that his organization will have a meeting a week from Saturday. They hope to have the webpage up by the end of the month. 10,000 flyers have been printed. They have a temporary studio at UFM. The committee will be going out to talk to the community.

Speaker Series: Tveite has asked Shields to make travel arrangements. Renner volunteered to make up a flyer if Tveite will get information to him. Exdell will get faculty names and email addresses to Tveite. Exdell will also talk to the history department about funds for Shields. Tveite and Force will have to meet about publicity. Tveite committed to speak with the Arab student organization with regards to gaining funds for Dr. Shields' lecture. Covington volunteered to work with Tveite on this effort and felt that the local Mosque might also be willing to contribute. Tveite will see if Shields will be staying with Cowan.

No-NBAF: Debbie Nuss is working on a statement for MAPJ. Exdell said that no-NBAF group should write up talking points for any future discussion. Covington will follow up on this.

On going Business:

Survey/Special Mgt. Tveite reported that there were 99 responses to the survey. Jon T. will present the survey @the beginning of the meeting. The goal of the meeting will be to reach out to new groups and come up with tangible goals. The agenda will be as follows:

1. Introduction to the survey and its criteria.
2. Split into interest groups and see if it is a viable project.
3. Reconvene and present concerns.
4. Set objectives then set strategy.

Budget: Cowan sent the budget to board. The board discussed the budget, it was accepted.

Newsletter: Cowan reported that the newsletter content committee will meet at her house on Sept. 30 at 7:00pm. Articles will be due to Buck on Oct. 14th, Renner will do the layout the weekend of Oct 17th, we will fold it on Oct 21st and it will be mailed October 22.
